**Research Analysis**

HB 3998 clarifies the education and training reimbursement requirements of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training. The measure requires that reimbursement be made if the officer leaves the employing agency within one year from the date the person was commissioned with the law enforcement agency instead of within one year of employment with the agency.
