## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 4130 defines new terms "Learning pod" and "Microschool," requires parents to submit letter of intent when requesting a change in educational instruction, and directs the Department of Human Services (OKDHS) to perform a background check, maintain a system for biannual checks, and prohibit instruction in the home if there is abuse, neglect, or violence; explaining the reason for denial.

After communication with OKDHS, the anticipated fiscal impact of this measure is either an estimated \$18,800,000.00 or \$1,300,000.00, depending on whether background check costs are passed to the client.
