Research Analysis

HJR 1017 as introduced, authorizes a delegation of commissioners to attend and participate in a gathering of states proposed by any state legislature and to serve at an Article V Convention. The delegation is to be composed of 7 commissioners appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Temp of the Senate. Appointees are to be both current and former members. Commissioners are not allowed to vote for an unauthorized amendment for ratification to the U.S. Constitution and must take an oath before accepting appointment.

The measure also creates the Article V Convention Committee to be composed of three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Temp of the Senate. Members of the Article V Convention Committee are not to be members of the delegation of commissioners. The duties of the Article V Convention Committee are to advise the delegation of commissioners on the Legislature's position on issues, to monitor, and discipline any commissioner in violation of their oath of office.
