**Bill Analysis**

SB 1017 directs every state agency receiving funds from the state or federal government to apply improvement methodologies, tools, and techniques to the agency's projects and practices to improve efficiency. Practices agencies are expected to adopt are outlined in the measure. Agencies shall be required to conduct performance evaluations each quarter and present the findings for evaluation by the newly created Oklahoma Government Efficiency Advisory Board. The Board shall be comprised of 9 members. The chair of the Board shall be chosen among and by members of the Board. The Board is directed to meet at least quarterly and to appoint a Waste Efficiency Advisory Team.
