**Bill Analysis**

SB 1017 modifies language related to sex education materials. It prohibits a survey or questionnaire administered as part of sex education from including topics relating to gender or sexuality. The bill also prohibits public school districts, public charter schools, and public school libraries from maintaining in its inventory or using in its curriculum books that make as their primary subject the study of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender issues, or recreational sexualization. It prohibits a public school teacher from discussing or administering a survey or questionnaire to students about gender or sexuality. The bill clarifies that its provisions do not apply to acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS) prevention education.
