Bill Analysis

SB 126 directs an arresting law enforcement agency to notify a school superintendent if it is discovered that the person being arrested for a violent crime is a student in a school district or public school in this state. The measure directs the information to be kept as part of the student's permanent records. The bill also states that beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, prior to a student enrolling in a public school, the student's parent or legal guardian is required to notify the school if the student has been arrested for a violent crime.
