Bill Analysis

SB 1375 prohibits any licensed food establishment from offering any food or other product intended for human consumption that contains cell-cultured meat unless the establishment discloses such a fact to customers following rules promulgated by the State Commissioner of Health. The measure provides that a food establishment shall not be penalized through fines, license suspension or revocation, or other administrative action by the Department. Such establishments shall not be liable for any civil damages if the licensed food establishment makes a good-faith effort to comply with the provisions of this measure.
