## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 1639 modifies the definition of *kratom product*, as used in the Oklahoma Kratom Consumer Protection Act, to include food or dietary supplements consisting of kratom leaf or extract that contain synthesized kratom alkaloids or any other synthesized constituent with a level of 7-hydroxmyitragynine not to exceed one percent (1%) of its total alkaloid composition.

This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
