**Bill Analysis**

SB 1644 requires persons leaving a vessel, other than a personal watercraft, on the waters in the state to display a red or orange flag measuring not less than 12 by 12 inches. The flag shall not be displayed when the watercraft is engaged in towing any person but shall be displayed when such person has ceased being towed and has reentered the water. The measure also prohibits any person from knowingly operating a vessel in excess of a slow or no-wake speed within 50 yards a vessel displaying the flag. The measure also defines wide-angle rearview mirrors.
