Research Analysis

The committee amendment to SB 1818, cited as the "Marissa Murrow Act", establishes an event venue license overseen by the ABLE Commission, with an annual fee of \$500. An event venue is defined as any location or property owned, leased, or occupied by a commercial business registered with the Oklahoma Secretary of State or a foreign commercial business authorized to operate in Oklahoma that offer their space to the general public for rent, lease, reservation, or other contractual use for hosting temporary functions, occasions, or events, whether special, private, or public. However, this definition excludes venues owned, leased, or occupied by tax-exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, specifically those classified under Section 501(c)(3).
