Bill Analysis

SB 1880 prohibits a school district or charter school from compelling an employee or volunteer to refer to a student with a pronoun other than that which corresponds to the student's biological sex. The measure prohibits print or nonprint materials or multimedia resources in school districts from referring to an individual by a name or a pronoun that does not correspond to the individual's biological sex. The measure allows the State Board of Education, upon a finding of noncompliance, to reduce state funding by 5% of the noncompliant school district or charter school. It creates a cause of action for an enrolled student's parent or legal guardian against a school district or charter school for noncompliance.
