SB 230 requires the state emergency operations plan to include a plan of response to a catastrophic health emergency. The measure also repeals [Title 63 Section 6105](#), which relates to the Oklahoma Catastrophic Health Emergency Planning Task Force.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 230 requires the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (OEM) to ensure that a component of the emergency operations plan for the state includes catastrophic health emergencies, and repeals a section of statute that authorizes the creation of the Oklahoma Catastrophic Health Emergency Task Force. The OEM, who works closely with the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) on the catastrophic health emergency plan, states that the State Emergency Operations Plan already contains language for catastrophic health emergencies. Therefore, the agency does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this measure
