**Bill Analysis**

SB 268 adds temporary roofer endorsement to the list of professions that may be temporarily authorized by the Construction Industries Board following the Governor's declared state of emergency after a natural disaster. The measure also reduces the minimum time period at which an applicant may take an exam for licensure after failing said exam from 30 days to 10 days for the first failure and 90 days to 30 days after the second failure.
