Research Analysis

SB 283 requires a person convicted of knowingly and willfully permitting any individual under 21 years of age who is an invitee to the person's residence, any building, structure or room owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person or on any land owned, occupied, leased or otherwise procured by the person, to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage to attend a victims impact panel program. The measure requires a person convicted of providing alcohol to a person under 21 years of age to attend a victims impact panel program.
