**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB 499 authorizes the Attorney General to institute and prosecute certain criminal actions and provide assistance to a district attorney without first obtaining permission from the Governor.

The measure additionally broadens the scope in which the Attorney General can bring certain motions, issue subpoenas, and authorize certain filings and reports.

The measure also repeals [22 O.S. Section 524](#), which outlines request timetables of preliminary hearings on felony indictments.
