Research Analysis

The engrossed version of SB 612 requires the Oklahoma Lottery Commission to conduct a background check on every employee every year.

Further, the measure:

Removes the requirement for the Commission to submit a specific report;

Requires anyone winning a lottery prize of more than \$5,000 to provide the Tax Commission with their name, social security number or tax identification number, proof of SS number of tax identification number, and valid ID before receiving their money. All information will be kept confidential except for the person's first name, city of residence, and prize amount.

Requires anyone receiving a lottery prize as a trust to provide proof of social security number or tax identification number, and trust certifications prior to payment.

Removes language referring to of the Lottery Retailer Advisory Board and Oklahoma Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee

Repeals these sections of law:

Section 706 - Lottery Retailer Advisory Board - Appointment - Members - Terms - Meetings

Section 734 - Oklahoma Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee
