Engrossed SB650 raises the cap on the state employee flexible benefit allowance, from the amount of benefit a participant would have qualified for in plan year 2012 to \$778.67 for a single claimant or, for claimants with dependents, \$667.32 plus applicable percentages for those dependents.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 650 in its current form, increases state employee benefit allowance amounts. Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) estimate that based on the current population of state employees, if the provisions of SB 650 where in place during the 2021 plan year, an additional cost to state agencies equaling \$1,759,039 statewide, would have resulted.
