Bill Analysis

SB 662 expands the duties of the Oklahoma Workforce Commission to require it to implement programs designed to expand workforce development. The Commission shall also work with, use, and provide data on the legislatively created map developed to help make decisions on economic development and workforce needs. The Commission shall address high demand and critical workforce development, provide work-based learning opportunities, and address public school innovation. The Commission may administer these programs using monies in the Workforce Coordination Revolving Fund. The measure also creates the Oklahoma Workforce Commission Revolving Fund.

House Amendments

HA's to SB 662 adds language relating to the legislatively created map and the revolving fund.
