## **Fiscal Analysis**

SB 677 stipulates that the place of residence and mailing address of those filing Declarations of Candidacy will remain confidential but may be provided to any lawful authority as part of a contest of candidacy or contest of election. This measure also requires those filing Declarations of Candidacy to provide a voter registration verification form, provided by the Secretary of the Election Board. The State Election Board (SEB) currently estimates that the programming costs and alterations to the Declaration of Candidacy forms can be completed for a total fiscal impact of less than \$20,000.

The CCR to SB 677 rescinds the House amendment and restores the title; therefore, there is no change in the fiscal impact analysis from the previous engrossed version.
