**Bill Analysis**

SB 729 requires the Executive Director of the Department of Corrections to place inmates requesting parole on the first available parole review docket if such inmates are 50 years of age or older, medically frail, and serving time for offenses outlined in the measure. A medically frail person is defined as a person who is a minimal threat to society, unable to perform 2 or more activities of daily living, unable to move or facing severe challenges to move. Medical conditions for medical frailty are outlined in the measure.
