## **Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute to SB 773 transfers the authority to provide licenses and registration for aircraft from the Oklahoma Tax Commission to Service Oklahoma effective July 1, 2024.

Additionally, the measure clarifies that the Oklahoma Advanced Mobility Pilot Program is to focus on developing and improving transportation technologies such as advanced ground transportation, autonomous ground vehicles, advanced air mobility vehicles, and autonomous vertical take-off or landing vehicles. Also, the Program is to seek to enhance the interaction between modes of transportation to ensure Oklahomans are best prepared for the advancement of future technologies. The measure allows for the Department of Transportation to select certain government entities, such as cities, counties and tribal governments, to receive two matching grant awards of up to \$500,000 each to aid in the adoption of advanced mobility technologies. Lastly, the measure creates the Oklahoma Advanced Air Mobility Revolving Fund to be used to invest in advanced air mobility and unmanned aircraft systems and associated infrastructure.
