**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to the floor substitute to SB 941 provides that certain licenses are required to hunt in a commercial hunt area and adds a five day hunting license for nonresidents for hunting winged upland game, excluding wild turkey in a commercial hunting area with a fee of \$15.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure makes several changes to the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation's (ODWC) various hunting and fishing licenses, including several fee increases and the ability to update fees every 5 years based on the Consumer Price Index. ODWC estimates, these changes will help increase revenue between \$10,000,000-\$12,000,000 depending on how quickly licenses are purchased. As ODWC is a non-appropriated agency there is no impact to the state budget from this measure.

The Amendment to the Floor Substitute does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.
