14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1276, as							
15	amended by Section 5, Chapter 259, O.S.L. 2012 (21 O.S. Supp. 2018,							
16	Section 1276), is amended to read as follows:

18	PENALTY FOR 1272 AND 1273							
19	<u>A.</u> Any person violating the provisions of Section 1272 <del>or 1273</del>							
20	of this title shall, upon a first conviction, be <del>adjudged</del> guilty of							
21	a misdemeanor and the party offending shall be punished by a fine of							
22	not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Two							
23	Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), or by imprisonment in the county							
24	jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days or both such fine

and imprisonment. On the second and every subsequent violation, the party offending person shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not less than thirty (30) days nor more than three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

7 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of Section 8 1272 or 1273 of this title after having been issued a handgun 9 license pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act 10 shall have the license suspended for a period of six (6) months and 11 shall be liable for an administrative fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) 12 upon a hearing and determination by the Oklahoma State Bureau of 13 Investigation that the person is in violation of the provisions of 14 this section shall, upon a first conviction, be guilty of a 15 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than One 16 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars 17 (\$250.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to 18 exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. On 19 the second and every subsequent violation, the person shall, upon 20 conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than Two Hundred Fifty 21 Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or 22 by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not less than 23 thirty (30) days nor more than ninety (90) days, or by both such 24 fine and imprisonment.
