8 An Act relating to birthright citizenship; defining
9 terms; specifying policies under certain
 circumstances; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8000 of Title 36, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. As used in this act:

18 1. "Fertilization" means the fusion of a human spermatozoon
19 with a human ovum.

20 B. Once fertilization has occurred, the unborn child in
21 question shall have birthright citizenship under the Fourteenth
22 Amendment of the United States Constitution. This right shall exist
23 in the State of Oklahoma regardless of the citizenship status of
24 either parent of the unborn child.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
