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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
20	Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
21	Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
22	One Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars
23	(\$148,650.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
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of Commerce, be allocated to support the International Protocol
 Office within the Department.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 3 4 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 5 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of 6 Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall, under the 7 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be utilized to 8 support geographic information systems (GIS), mapping, and other 9 technology needs the Department has in supporting its divisions. 10 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 11 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 12 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of 13 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the 14 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the 15 Agriculture Initiative within the Department. Such funds shall be 16 used to attract new agriculture industry companies and help support 17 existing agriculture industry companies.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to support the Small Business Development Centers. Such funds shall be

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1 used to establish additional centers in areas of the state that do
2 not currently have a center.

3 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
5 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
6 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the
7 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
8 support Oklahoma Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance.

9 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma 10 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st 11 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of 12 Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) shall, under the 13 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to 14 Seminole State College's Rural Business and Resources Center.

SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to help stand-up and support the Murray State College's Gunsmithing Technology degree program.

SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall, under the
 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
 Northeastern Oklahoma A&M Agriculture Rodeo program.

4 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including 5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24) or may be 6 7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25). Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30, 8 9 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds 10 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 11 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June 12 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse 13 14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay 17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after 18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 20 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been 21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
