8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
9 Commerce; requiring that portions of certain funds be
10 utilized for certain purposes; providing budgeting
11 and expenditure limitations and procedures; and
12 providing for lapse of funds under certain
13 conditions.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
17 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
18 One Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars
19 (\$148,650.00) shall, under the direction of the Executive Director
20 of Commerce, be allocated to support the International Protocol
21 Office within the Department.

22 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
23 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
24 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of

1 Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall, under the
2 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be utilized to
3 support geographic information systems (GIS), mapping, and other
4 technology needs the Department has in supporting its divisions.

5 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
6 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
7 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
8 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the
9 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to the
10 Agriculture Initiative within the Department. Such funds shall be
11 used to attract new agriculture industry companies and help support
12 existing agriculture industry companies.

13 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
14 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
15 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
16 One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall, under the
17 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
18 support the Small Business Development Centers. Such funds shall be
19 used to establish additional centers in areas of the state that do
20 not currently have a center.

21 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
22 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
23 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
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1 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall, under the
2 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
3 support Oklahoma Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance.

4 SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
5 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
6 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
7 Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) shall, under the
8 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
9 Seminole State College's Rural Business and Resources Center.

10 SECTION 7. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
11 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
12 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
13 Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) shall, under the direction of
14 the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to help stand-up
15 and support the Murray State College's Gunsmithing Technology degree
16 program.

17 SECTION 8. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
18 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 1004 of the 1st
19 Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
20 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall, under the
21 direction of the Executive Director of Commerce, be allocated to
22 Northeastern Oklahoma A&M Agriculture Rodeo program.

23 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
