7	An Act relating to the Legacy Capital Financing Fund; authorizing utilization of portion of certain amount
8	for certain purpose benefitting the Office of Management and Enterprise Services; requiring certain
9	recapitalization payments; authorizing certain distributions; authorizing and limiting utilization
10	of memoranda of understanding; repealing Section 1, Chapter 320, O.S.L. 2022 (73 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
11	382), which relates to authorized debt for the Jim Thorpe Office Building; repealing Section 1, Chapter
12	345, O.S.L. 2022 (73 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 384), which relates to authorized debt for the Capitol
13	Complex Tunnels; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an
14	emergency.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187A-5 of Title 73, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the
21	Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize
22	available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by
23	Enrolled House Bill No. 1002 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the
24	59th Oklahoma Legislature, in the amounts of:

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Seventy Million Dollars (\$70,000,000.00) for the benefit of
 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to repair,
 refurbish, and improve the real and personal property of the Jim
 Thorpe Office Building;

Nineteen Million Dollars (\$19,000,000.00) for the benefit of
the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to repair,
refurbish, and improve the real and personal property constituting
the tunnels underlying the State Capitol Office Complex and
associated fixtures and equipment; and

3. Twenty-six Million Three Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$26,322,300.00) for the benefit of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to accept transfer of the Kelley Building and Kelley Annex owned by the Department of Human Services and renovate the facilities for lease to a public operator as a day care facility.

B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the
distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this section,
in accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing
Act.

C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to
subsection A of this section in one or more tranches.

D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda

7	(73 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 384), is hereby repealed.
8	SECTION 4. Section 1 of this act shall become effective August
9	1, 2023.
10	SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
