NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 187A-2 of Title 73, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 In addition to any other authorization provided by law, the 20 Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority is authorized to utilize 21 available funds from the Legacy Capital Financing Fund created by 22 Enrolled House Bill No. 1002 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 23 59th Oklahoma Legislature, in the amount of Seventy-nine Million 24 Dollars (\$79,000,000.00) for the benefit of the Oklahoma State

1	University Veterinary Medicine Authority (OSUVMA) created pursuant
2	to Enrolled House Bill No. 2863 of the 1st Session of the 59th
3	Oklahoma Legislature to construct, refurbish, or expand animal

5	B. LCF Recapitalization Payments shall be made related to the
6	distribution of proceeds provided in subsection A of this act, in
7	accordance with the provisions of the Legacy Capital Financing Act.
8	C. The Authority may distribute funds authorized pursuant to
9	subsection A in one or more tranches.
10	D. The Authority may enter memoranda of understanding with
11	agencies, departments, and subdivisions of the state as needed, to
12	facilitate the provisions of this act, provided that such memoranda
13	of understanding do not constitute a legal obligation of the State
14	of Oklahoma or impede the administration of the provisions of the
15	Legacy Capital Financing Act.
