SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State University Medical Center by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma State University Medical Center. The salary of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma State University Medical Center shall not exceed Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. The Oklahoma State University Medical Center for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
