10	An Act relating to the University Hospitals
11	Authority; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12	amounts; providing for duties and compensation of employees; authorizing payment of certain expenses;
13	<pre>providing process for exemptions; providing procedures; providing lapse dates; requiring and</pre>
14	prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the University
19	Hospitals Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
20	the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21	ending June 30, 2018, the sum of Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
22	thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
23	University Hospitals Authority by law.

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1	SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the
2	University Hospitals Authority shall budget all funds in the
3	following categories and amounts:

6	SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7	otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8	upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the
9	Executive Director of the University Hospitals Authority. The
10	salary of the Executive Director of the University Hospitals
11	Authority shall not exceed Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
12	payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. The
13	University Hospitals Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30,
14	2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
15	full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
16	expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
17	authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
18	the Oklahoma Statutes:

22	SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23	appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
24	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be

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    budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).
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    Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
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    2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds
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    remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
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    lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
    year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
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 7
    30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
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    to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
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    These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
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    simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
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    obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
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    the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
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    and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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    from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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        SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
