10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission on
11	Children and Youth; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
12	and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of employees; authorizing payment of certain expenses;
13	providing process for exemptions; providing procedures; providing lapse dates; requiring and
14	prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
19	Commission on Children and Youth from any monies not otherwise
20	appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
21	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of Dollars
22	(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
23	imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the
Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth shall budget all funds in
the following categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not 7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth by law shall be 8 9 set by the Director of the Oklahoma Commission on Children and 10 Youth. The salary of the Director of the Oklahoma Commission on 11 Children and Youth shall not exceed Dollars (\$0.00) per 12 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. 13 The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth for the fiscal year 14 ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary 15 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures 16 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as 17 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of 18 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

23 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19). 2 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30, 3 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds 4 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall 5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 6 7 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse 8 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 10 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay 11 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after 12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 14 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been 15 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 16 SECTION 5.
