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| 18 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: |
| 19 | SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of |
| 20 | Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from any monies not |
| 21 | otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State |
| 22 | Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of |
| 23 | (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary |
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1 to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Mental Health 2 and Substance Abuse Services by law.

3 SECTION 2. In order to facilitate cash management of federal 4 grant receipts and disbursements, the Office of Management and 5 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies between the Department of 6 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services federal and revolving 7 funds in amounts requested by the Department of Mental Health and 8 Substance Abuse Services.

9 Receipt and expenditures of unanticipated federal funds awarded 10 the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services after 11 July 1, 2018, shall be exempt from expenditure and budgetary 12 limitations, provided that any such funds used for operations shall 13 be included in the agency's budget work program.

14 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including 15 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be 17 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19). 18 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30, 19 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds 20 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall 21 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 22 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 23 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse 24 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
