completed by the parent or guardian of a student annually at enrollment, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year. Districts shall report the results to the Department, in a manner prescribed by the Department, no later than April 1 of each year.

B. Beginning July 1, 2025, the Department shall compile a report of the number of students identified as being homeless, by district, and whether the students identified are in elementary, middle or junior high, or high school. The report shall be distributed annually to the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Chair of the House Common Education Committee, Speaker Pro Tempore of the Senate, Chair of the Senate Education Committee, and the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
