## 1 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2 1st Session of the 56th Legislature (2017) 3 HOUSE BILL 1040 By: Osborn (Leslie) and Wallace of the House 4 and 5 David and Fields of the 6 Senate 7 8 9 AS INTRODUCED 10 An Act relating to education; making appropriations to the State Board of Education; stating purposes; 11 authorizing certain expenditures; stating purpose; specifying the apportionment of certain funds which 12 were appropriated; providing for the budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring 1.3 transfer of funds to the School Consolidation Assistance Fund; requiring transfer of funds to the 14 Teachers' Retirement System Dedicated Revenue Revolving Fund; requiring the transfer of funds to 15 the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma for the Teachers' Retirement Credit; requiring funds 16 allocated for Education Leadership Oklahoma to be transferred and expended for certain purposes; 17 stating purposes for funds allocated for Reform Implementation; stating purposes for funds allocated 18 for Alternative and High Challenge Education; stating purpose for funds allocated for Financial 19 Literacy; requiring transfer of Early Intervention funds; stating intent regarding cost reimbursement 20 for indirect administrative costs in the Oklahoma Early Intervention Act; stating purpose for funds 2.1 allocated for the Early Childhood Initiative; stating purpose for funds allocated for the Parent 22 Training Program; stating purpose for funds allocated for the Rural Infant Stimulation 23 Environment (RISE) Program; providing for duties and compensation of employees of the State Department of

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Education; providing budgetary limitations;

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requiring the reduction or withholding of State Aid funds for certain purposes; authorizing the State Board of Education to request certain transfer of funds; providing for certain proportional reduction of funds; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budgeting procedures; prohibiting certain budgeting procedures; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.
- SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 34.89 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.
- SECTION 3. The State Board of Education is hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, from the Common Education Technology Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum

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of Dollars ($0.00) or so much thereof as may be
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    necessary for the financial support of public schools.
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       SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
    Education, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
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    Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
    ending June 30, 2018, the sum of Dollars ($0.00) or so
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    much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public
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    schools.
       SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of

Dollars (\$0.00) shall be used for School Competitive Grants Pool. These funds shall be made available on a statewide competitive application basis as specified by the State Department of Education. SECTION 23. The funds allocated in Section 16 of this act for Alternative and High Challenge Education shall be expended for the purpose of operating the statewide system of alternative education programs as provided in Section 1210.568 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and for encouraging school districts to participate in innovative alternative education programs. The funds shall be expended as follows: 1. Dollars (\$0.00) for statewide programs; and \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) for program evaluation, technical assistance and staff development conducted by the contracted technical assistance provider as provided for in Section 1210.568 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. SECTION 24. The funds allocated in Section 16 of this act for Financial Literacy shall be used to implement the provisions of Section 11-103.6h of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. SECTION 25. The funds allocated in Section 16 of this act for Early Intervention shall be transferred to the fund designated within the Office of Management and Enterprise Services as the Early Intervention Fund 250. It is the intent of the Legislature that

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funding available for SoonerStart Early Intervention Services be

expended for direct services to eligible infants, toddlers and their families. The State Department of Education shall not contract, pay or reimburse for administrative cost recovery personnel, accounting, and management information system costs, maintenance and operations at the state or local level or indirect costs which do not comply with the requirements of Section 13-125 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 26. The funds allocated in Section 16 of this act for the Early Childhood Initiative shall be expended for the purpose of funding the early childhood program pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-105.4 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 27. The funds allocated in Section 16 of this act for the Parent Training Program, as authorized in Section 10-105.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be expended for the continuation and expansion of the Oklahoma Parents as Teachers Program.

SECTION 28. The funds allocated for the Rural Infant
Stimulation Environment (RISE) Program in Section 16 of this act
shall be used for capital expenditures and operations for a school
designed to serve children with disabilities from birth to five (5)
years of age.

SECTION 29. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Education by law shall be set by the

State Board of Education. The State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

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SECTION 30. State Aid funds shall be reduced or withheld by the State Board of Education in an amount necessary to ensure compliance with the provisions of this act.

SECTION 31. The State Board of Education is authorized to request the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer appropriated funds to the appropriate dispensing fund.

SECTION 32. If funds appropriated in this act are not sufficient to fully fund the provisions of this act, each school district which qualifies for funds, excluding Financial Support of Public Schools, pursuant to the provisions of this act shall take a proportionate reduction.

SECTION 33. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).

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    Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
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    2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds
    remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
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    lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
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    year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
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    30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
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    to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
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    These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
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    simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
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    obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
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    the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
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    and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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    from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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        SECTION 34. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
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
