L7	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 229, O.S.L.							
L8	2017, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 2017 (72 O.S.							
L 9	Supp. 2018, Section 421), is amended to read as follows:							
20	Section 421. A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs							
21	shall create and maintain a registry of all veterans in this state							
22	by January 1, 2020. The registry shall be designated the "Oklahoma							
23	Veterans Registry" and shall include the following information							
24	regarding the veteran:							

1 1. Name;

- 2. Military ranking rank and branch of service;
- Dates of service;
- 4. Documentation Percentage of one hundred percent (100%)
  service-disability service-connected disability, if applicable; and
- 5. Date of death and place of <del>burial</del> <u>interment</u>, if applicable;

  - 6. Name of spouse, if applicable.
  - B. As a component of the veterans registry created pursuant to subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall designate those veterans within the registry as one—hundred\_percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans, if applicable. The registry designation shall also be maintained as a separate list within the registry for all one—hundred—percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall be responsible for verification of all information provided through the registry and shall verify veteran service disability status at least once every four (4) years.
  - C. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall promulgate rules for implementing the provisions of this section.
  - D. For purposes of this section, "veteran" means a person who served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States who was discharged or released with an honorable discharge. For those veterans with a designation of one hundred percent (100%) service-

- 2 | percentage of one hundred percent (100%) by the United States
- 3 Department of Veterans Affairs shall have the same meaning as

- 5 | SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

- 17 | Statutes. The Social Security number of an individual veteran shall

- 19 Department shall transmit to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans

- 22 2. The veteran's Social Security number;
- 23 3. Date of death; and
