- B. Each school district in this state shall utilize guidelines and resource information from a statewide organization of athletic trainers in an effort to achieve a Safe Sports School Award.
- C. Subject to the availability of funds, the State Department of Education shall provide a one-time grant award of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) to each public school district that achieves a Safe Sports School Award. Such awards shall be given over a five-year period to no more than fifteen school districts per year. Preferences shall be given to school districts that have not previously hired a comprehensive athletic healthcare team coordinator.
- D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement subsection C of this section.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
