9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Labor; making  
11 appropriations; stating purposes; requiring budgeting  
12 in certain categories and amounts; providing for  
13 duties and compensation of employees; providing  
14 budgetary limitations; requiring certain budget  
15 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;  
16 providing lapse dates; and providing an effective  
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
20 Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special  
21 Occupational Health and Safety Fund of the State Treasury for the  
22 fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
23 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
24 imposed upon the Department of Labor by law.

1 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
 2 Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special  
 3 Occupational Health and Safety Fund of the State Treasury for the  
 4 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
 5 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
 6 imposed upon the Department of Labor by law.

7 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the  
 8 Department of Labor shall budget all funds in the following  
 9 categories and amounts:

19 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 20 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 21 upon the Department of Labor by law shall be set by the Commissioner  
 22 of Labor. The Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending June  
 23 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
 24 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding

1 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
2 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
3 the Oklahoma Statutes:

7 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
8 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be  
10 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).  
11 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
12 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds  
13 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall  
14 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
15 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June  
16 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse  
17 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
18 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
19 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay  
20 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after  
21 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
22 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
23 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been  
24 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
