SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19). Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
