17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 12-101, as
18	amended by Section 1, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2018,
19	Section 12-101), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 12-101. A. Except as otherwise provided by law,
21	whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of a member of the
22	United States Senate or United States House of Representatives from
23	Oklahoma, such vacancy shall be filled at a Special Election to be

 thirty (30) days after such vacancy occurs.

B. No special election shall be called if the <u>such a</u> vacancy occurs <u>in the office of a member of the United States Senate</u> in an even-numbered year if the term of the office expires the following year. In such case, the candidate elected to the office at the regular General Election shall be appointed by the Governor to fill the unexpired term.

9 C. If such a vacancy occurs in the office of a member of the 10 United States House of Representatives in an even-numbered year, the Regular Primary Election, Runoff Primary Election or General 11 12 Election for that office shall be deemed to also serve as a Special Election to fill the unexpired term as designated by the Governor. 13 Within thirty (30) days after such vacancy occurs, the Governor 14 shall issue a Writ of Election declaring the same, and the candidate 15 16 elected at the Regular Election shall be deemed to have also been elected at a Special Election to fill the unexpired term. 17 D. The proclamation required by Section 12-102 of this title 18 shall serve as the Writ of Election described in this section. 19 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 12-103, as 20 amended by Section 2, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2012 (26 O.S. Supp. 2018, 21 Section 12-103), is amended to read as follows: 22 Section 12-103. A filing period of three (3) days, on a Monday, Tuesday and
 Wednesday not less than ten (10) days from the date of such
 proclamation;

8 twenty (20) days after the close of the filing period;

9 3. The date of the Special Runoff Primary Election, not less
10 than twenty (20) days after the date of the Special Primary
11 Election; and

12 4. The date of the Special General Election, not less than
13 twenty (20) days after the date of the Special Runoff Primary
14 Election.

15 Should such a vacancy occur in an even-numbered year, when a 16 special election is required, the proclamation must contain dates that are the same as are required by law for the regular filing 17 period, Primary Election, Runoff Primary Election and General 18 Election, if practicable. 19 20 SECTION 3.
