7 An Act relating to the Department of Human Resources;
8 providing legislative intent; and declaring an
9 emergency.

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
13 the Department of Human Services fully fund in its entirety the
14 Advantage Home and Community-based Waiver Program, Money Follows the
15 Person, Homeward Bound Waiver, In-home Supports, Advantage Waiver
16 and Personal Care within the Department of Human Services in FY-2018
17 with all of the state, federal, and other existing financial
18 resources available to the Department, including increasing state
19 funds to make up for the loss of Federal FMAP funds so that total
20 spending in FY-2018 is no less than FY-2017. It is further the
21 Oklahoma Legislature's intent that services to clients and related
22 provider rates within the Advantage Home and Community-based Waiver
23 Program, Money Follows the Person, Homeward Bound Waiver, In-home
24 Supports, Advantage Waiver and Personal Care not be cut in FY-2018.

1 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
2 the Department of Human Services fully fund in its entirety the
3 Senior Nutrition Program within the Aging Services Division in FY-
4 2018 with all of the state, federal and other existing financial
5 resources available to the Department so that total spending in FY-
6 2018 is no less than FY-2017.

7 SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that
8 the Department of Human Services fully fund in its entirety the
9 Developmental Disabilities Services programs and services within the
10 Department of Human Services in FY-2018 with all of the state,
11 federal and other existing financial resources available to the
12 Department, including increasing state funds to make up for the loss
13 of Federal FMAP funds so that total spending in FY-2018 is no less
14 than FY-2017. It is further the Oklahoma Legislature's intent that
15 services to current DDSD clients and related provider rates to such
16 clients not be reduced in FY-2018.

17 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
