9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Council on Law Enforcement  
11 Education and Training; making appropriations;  
12 stating purposes; requiring budgeting in certain  
13 categories and amounts; providing for the duties and  
14 compensation of employees; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; providing exceptions to the budgetary  
16 limitations; requiring certain budget practices;  
17 prohibiting certain budget practices; providing lapse  
18 dates; and providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law  
21 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise  
22 appropriated from the CLEET Fund of the State Treasury for the  
23 fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
24 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties

1 imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training  
2 by law.

3 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law  
4 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise  
5 appropriated from the CLEET Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
6 2016, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
8 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

9 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law  
10 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise  
11 appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the  
12 sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be  
13 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law  
14 Enforcement Education and Training by law.

15 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the  
16 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall budget all  
17 funds in the following categories and amounts:

23 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law  
2 shall be set by the Director. The Council on Law Enforcement  
3 Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018,  
4 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
5 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures  
6 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
7 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
8 Oklahoma Statutes:

12 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be  
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).  
16 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
17 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds  
18 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall  
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June  
21 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse  
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
23 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay

1 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after  
2 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
3 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
4 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been  
5 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

6 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

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
