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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
20	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of		
21	Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the		
22	General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year		
23	ending June 30, 2018, the sum of Dollars (\$0.00) or so

much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for

10	SECTION 4. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of	
11	Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Dollars (\$0.00)	
12	shall be expended for the services of a Capitol Patrol Officer to	
13	the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court of Existing Claims pursuant	
14	to a contract between the Department of Public Safety and the	
15	Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court of Existing Claims.	
16	SECTION 5. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of	
17	Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Dollars (\$0.00)	
18	shall be expended for the annual lease payment of the	
19	Clinton/Sherman Industrial Complex.	
20	SECTION 6. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of	
21	Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Dollars (\$0.00)	
22	shall be transferred to the Department of Public Safety Patrol	
23	Academy Revolving Fund. The Department of Public Safety, for the	
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fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, is authorized to have one Patrol
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    Academy consisting of no fewer than cadets.
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        SECTION 7. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized
    to expend Dollars ($0.00) from the Department of Public
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    Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund for the fiscal year ending June
    30, 2018, for the purchase of patrol vehicles and aircraft and

    equipping those vehicles and aircraft.
        SECTION 8. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
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    Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Dollars ($0.00)
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    shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Climatological Survey, under
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    the direction and supervision of the Board of Regents of the
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    University of Oklahoma, for the use of the Survey to perform its
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    duties as prescribed by law.
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        SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including
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    appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
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    the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be
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    budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).
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    Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,
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    2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds
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    remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall
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    lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
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    year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June
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    30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse
    to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
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    These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
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    simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay
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    obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after
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    the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
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    and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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    from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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        SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
