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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; prohibiting
8 executive branch expenditures for certain purposes;
9 specifying prohibited expenditures; designating
10 fiscal years during which certain expenditures
11 prohibited; providing for final determinations
12 regarding expenditures by State Auditor and Inspector
13 or designee; providing for codification; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.301 of Title 62, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2018, June 30, 2019, and
20 June 30, 2020, no executive branch agency, board, commission,
21 department or other entity organized within the executive branch of
22 state government shall expend any funds on nonessential items to be
23 provided to persons or legal entities, including, but not limited
24 to, items of tangible personal property for purposes of promoting or
advertising the name of the state government entity or its missions,
duties or functions, such as magnets, buttons, bumper stickers,

1 ribbons, awards, prizes, trophies, stationery, writing implements,
2 legal pad holders, book bags or similar items. In the event of a
3 dispute regarding authority for an expenditure, the State Auditor
4 and Inspector, or a designee, shall make a final determination
5 regarding the authority for the agency expenditure and whether or
6 not the expenditure is essential.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
