contract requires the contractor to furnish.

For a contract not exceeding Fifty Thousand Dollars 14 (\$50,000.00) One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), in lieu of 15 a bond or irrevocable letter of credit, the contractor shall submit 16 an affidavit of the payment of all indebtedness incurred by the 17 contractor, the contractor's subcontractors, and all suppliers of 18 labor, material, rented machinery or equipment, and repair of and 19 parts for equipment used or consumed in the performance of the 20 contract.
