16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

19	The Department of Corrections is authorized to negotiate and
20	enter into a water purchase agreement and execute necessary
21	easements with a public nonprofit rural water district organized
22	under the Rural Water, Sewer, Gas and Solid Waste Management
23	Districts Act for purposes of selling at cost groundwater found
24	beneath real property owned by the Department, on which the

Lexington Assessment and Reception Center and the Joseph Harp
Correctional Center at Lexington, Oklahoma, are located, and for
granting permission to the Department to amend the groundwater use
permit the Department holds from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board
to allow for use as a public water supply. The term of the water
purchase agreement and easement shall be for not less than forty
(40) years from the first date of delivery of water and as long as
the groundwater is being put to a beneficial use. Any agreement
entered into for the sale of water shall include a reserved right of
usage by the Oklahoma Department of Corrections.
