BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

14

in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-702f of Title 63, unless there

15

is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund

17

for the Oklahoma State Department of Health to be designated the

18

"Uncompensated Care Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not

19

subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of any monies

20

received from any sources of funds provided by law. All monies

21

accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and shall

22

be budgeted and expended by the Department of Health for the purpose

23

of providing reimbursement of uncompensated care at federally

24

qualified community health centers. Expenditures from the fund

1 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
2 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
3 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

4 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 109, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
5 2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 5-106), is amended to read as
6 follows:

7 Section 5-106. All revenues generated from the gross receipts
8 tax levied pursuant to Section ~~108~~ 5-105 of this ~~act~~ title shall be
9 apportioned as follows:

10 1. Ninety-five percent (95%) of such tax shall be paid to the
11 State Treasurer and placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund
12 of the State of Oklahoma; and

13 2. Five percent (5%) of such tax shall be credited to the
14 Uncompensated Care Fund created pursuant to Section 1 of this act.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
