9 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; allowing
10 certain vehicle charging stations to qualify for per-
11 location credit upon enactment of certain bill and
12 until certain date; providing for maximum credits
13 used to offset tax; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2357.22A of Title 68, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Upon Enrolled House Bill 2234 of the 1st Session of the 58th
20 Oklahoma Legislature being signed into law, until January 1, 2023,
21 electric vehicle charging stations meeting the provisions of
22 subparagraph b of paragraph 3 of subsection B of Section 2357.22 of
23 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes may qualify for a per-location
24 credit of seventy-five percent (75%) of the cost of the qualified
clean-burning motor fuel property, pursuant to the provisions of

1 Section 2357.22 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Provided,
2 however, the total amount of credits authorized by this section used
3 to offset tax shall be limited to Five Million Dollars
4 (\$5,000,000.00).

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
