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10 An Act relating to roads and bridges; designating the
11 Jennifer Lea Briggs and Heather Wilson Memorial
12 Highway; designating the Keith Alan Copeland Memorial
13 Bridge; designating the CPL Eldon Ervin Memorial
14 Bridge; designating the Judge Ray Dean Linder
15 Interchange; designating the Senator Owen Laughlin
16 Bridge; designating the James Everett Clark III
17 Memorial Bridge; requiring placement of certain
18 permanent markers; providing for codification; and
19 providing an effective date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.250 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 33 in Payne County beginning at the
Cimarron River in southwest Payne County and extending east to the
junction of State Highway 33 and U.S. Highway 177 shall be
designated as the "Jennifer Lea Briggs and Heather Wilson Memorial

1 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.251 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Interstate 35 on Historic Route 66 in northern
7 Oklahoma County shall be designated as the "Keith Alan Copeland
8 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
10 bridge.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.252 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The bridge crossing over the BNSF Railroad on U.S. Highway 60
15 located approximately one and one-half (1.5) miles east of Wyandotte
16 in Ottawa County shall be designated as the "CPL Eldon Ervin
17 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
19 bridge.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.253 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The highway interchange of U.S. Highway 281 and State Highway 45
24 in Woods County shall be designated as the "Judge Ray Dean Linder

1 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
2 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at each approach to
3 the interchange.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.254 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over Sand Creek on U.S. Highway 270 located
8 approximately nine (9) miles southeast of the municipal limits of
9 Woodward, Oklahoma, in Woodward County shall be designated as the
10 "Senator Owen Laughlin Bridge". The Department of Transportation
11 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
12 placed on the bridge.

13 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.255 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge located on Interstate Highway 40 crossing S.E. 29th
17 Street in Midwest City shall be designated as the "James Everett
18 Clark III Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
19 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
20 the bridge.

21 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
