15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-417.1, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 3-417.1 Any private treatment facility, transitional
18	living center or halfway house, as defined in Section 3-403 of this
19	title, shall be subject to the nondiscriminatory zoning laws of the
20	state, county or municipality in which located, and the location of
21	such facility is specifically prohibited within one thousand (1,000)
22	feet of any public or private elementary or secondary school.
23	Provided, that if any public or private elementary or secondary
24	school shall be established within the prohibited distance from any

1 such facility after such facility has been in use as a treatment facility, transitional living center or halfway house, this shall 2 3 not be a bar to the continued use of the facility as designated so long as it remains in continuous use as designated. The distance 5 indicated in this section shall be measured from the nearest property line of the school to the nearest property line of the treatment facility, transitional living center or halfway house. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any treatment 9 facility, transitional living center or halfway house established 10 prior to the effective date of this act. 11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015. 12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby 13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 14 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
