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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2358.5-2 of Title 68, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2015, there
18	shall be exempt from taxable income all wages or other compensation
19	paid to a person performing services for an Oklahoma public utility
20	or Oklahoma rural electric cooperative on a temporary basis if the
21	person is a nonresident of the state at the time of such services,
22	performs the services at the request of or in cooperation with the
23	Oklahoma public utility or rural electric cooperative and the
24	services are performed in order to restore electric or gas service

to Oklahoma residents following the loss of electrical power or gas 1 2 service which results from a natural disaster, including, but not 3 limited to, tornado damage, severe storm damage, wind damage, hail 4 damage, ice accumulations or any other naturally occurring event 5 which causes or is responsible for loss of electric or gas service 6 to customers of the Oklahoma public utility or rural electric 7 cooperative and in response to the natural disaster the Governor of 8 this state declares a state of emergency.

9 B. For purposes of this section, performing services on a
10 "temporary basis" shall mean performing services for an Oklahoma
11 public utility or Oklahoma rural electric cooperative for a total of
12 not more than fourteen (14) days during a calendar year.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
